9. Historical significance (include explanation of themes checked above)

#15 Glenland Road, designed by Frederick Gowing in 1915, was built for Edward Mahoney who lived on Heath Street. Mahoney rented this two family house to a chauffeur and a gardener. A variation on this house's design is seen at 34 Sheafe Street, built in 1926. Similarities include the hipped dormer, hipped roof, large two story porch with open balustrade, and shingled exterior.
