#36 Glenland Road was built by Thaddeus O'Hearn who, like his neighbor at #15 Glenland Road, lived on Heath Street. O'Hearn, a policeman, rented this single family house to a consultant who worked in Boston. Although not a particularly distinguished building, #36 Glenland is an example of the type of housing which was constructed in this area during the 1920's.
