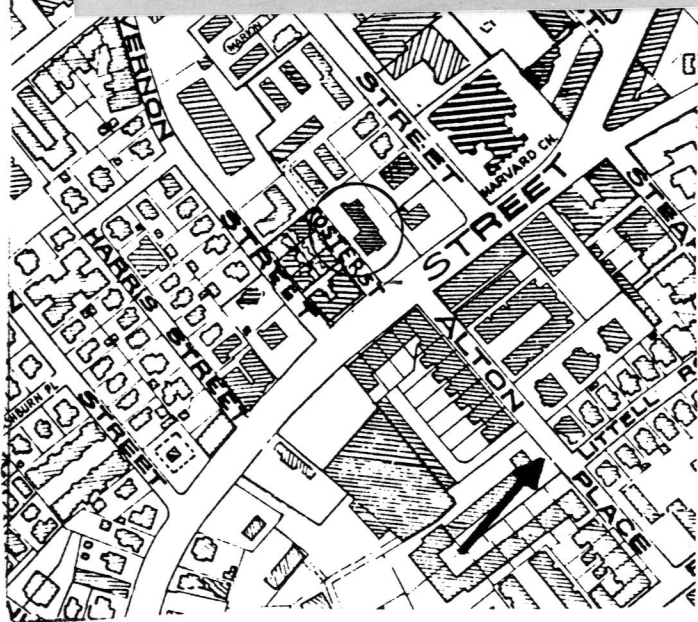

This five story brick apartment building consists of a long rectangular block with three wings projecting from the south side. The building is set back on the lot and includes a one story restaurant with metal and glass roof that extends across the front to the Harvard Street facade.
