91 Triton Avenue is neither individually eligible for the National Register nor located within an eligible district.

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within the community.

91 Triton Avenue is a modest 1 1/2 story house with a gable roof, end to the street. The first story of the facade contains an entry (east) and a modern picture window (west); a gable end window exists above. A one-story shed-roofed ell extends to the west, with a contemporary deck across its facade.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE Explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community.

Triton Avenue was planned in 1909, along with Bay View, Grandview, Undine and Foam Streets. The street was not listed in directories until the 1916-17 directory. Many of the houses listed in directories for the area were summer residences. Development began in the areas closest to the water; by the 1920's it had spread to those areas farther from the shoreline. Directory information does not clearly date the construction of this building, due to changes in street numbers.
